Reflections on 2012 at HSHC

2012 was a busy year at the Humane Society of Harford County. We assisted thousands of animals and customers, in keeping with our slogan to unite pets and people. Below are some highlights:

- We reunited nearly 450 lost animals with their grateful families through our lost & found program.
- We sent 232 animals to local rescue groups who assume the care of these animals and free up space at HSHC for other deserving animals.
- We adopted nearly 1,500 animals into their loving, forever homes.
- Twenty Girl Scout & Cub Scout troops held donation drives and toured our facilities, learning about responsible pet ownership. Garrett Anthony and Drew Lovell earned their Eagle Scout ranks after doing service projects at the shelter. Elizabeth Lelonek was awarded her Gold Award from the Girl Scouts of Central MD for renovations to our Free Roaming Cat Room.
- Our foster families cared for 447 animals!
- The Maryland Food Bank delivered 13,750 lbs. of food to stock our pet food pantry so we can help needy pet parents keep pets in their homes and out of the shelter.
- Our volunteers gave 9,685 hours walking and training dogs, caring for the cats, cuddling the small animals, fund-

- raising, staffing adoption events, and so much more.
- We expanded our Free Roaming Cat Room area.

We held many fundraisers throughout 2012 to raise operational funds. We must raise at least \$450,000 every year to keep our gates open. Over \$100,000 pays for spay/ neuter surgeries; supplies like gauze, needles and syringes; medications and kits to test for and prevent infectious diseases; and kennel supplies such as food and cleaning supplies. Our medical expenses continue to increase drastically and we need your continued support to keep our animals healthy. The cost for insurance, maintenance and repairs, office expenses, and utilities to ensure the animals are warm in the winter and cool in the summer amounts to over \$118,000! Your support of these fundraisers means the world to us:

We held our annual Bowl-a-Rama on

February 25, 2012 at Forest Hill Lanes. and over 160 people came to help strike out pet homelessness. Sponsored by Animal Emergency Hospital, net proceeds were \$12,500!

year's Bowl-a-Rama is February 23rd.

On Friday, May 4th the annual Bow Wow Boogie was held at the Richlin Ballroom and attracted over 420 guests! Sponsored by Animal Emergency Hospital, the event set an alltime record, netting \$40,000 to support

the animals!!! This year's Bow Wow Boogie will be May 3rd.

We organized two yard sales inside our Pole Barn: June 1-2 and August 31 -September 1. The public was asked to donate gently used household items, artwork, pet supplies and more. In total, the yard sales generated \$5,000. This year we will hold one giant yard sale on June 7 & 8!

- Max won our annual "Make Your Pet a Pin-Up" calendar contest this fall with 1.311 votes. We had 43 entries and 5,452 votes were cast...wow!
- Hundreds of pets and their people came out to the Harford County Equestrian Center to walk for homeless and neglected animals on November 3rd. 2012. The Walk & Wag-a-Thon and

Pet Fair with the Furry Friends 5K netted \$14,000. Animal Emergency Hospital was once again the top sponsor of this event.




