Is there a registration fee?

Yes. Each bowler must pay a pre-registration fee of \$20 by Wednesday, February 18th in order to bowl. The registration fee will only pay for your lane rental and bowling shoes. There will be no registration at the door on the day of the event.

How do I pre-register and reserve a lane?

To pre-register, visit www.harfordshelter.org by February 18th and follow the links to register and pay the \$20 per person pre-registration fee with your credit card—or call 410-836-1090, x111 to pay over the phone.

Each lane will have a maximum of 6 bowlers, so if you have less players, you may be paired with other bowlers. If you wish to compete against another team, please call 410-836-1090, x111 so we can assign lanes accordingly.

How does the raffle work?

For every \$50 you raise in pledges, you will receive 2 raffle tickets for a chance to win cool prizes. Raffle tickets will also be available for purchase at the event for \$3 each, two for \$5 or an arm's length for \$10.

What is the Bowl-a-Rama?

The Bowl-a-Rama is an important fundraiser that's a fun, family bowling event for adults and kids alike. It benefits the homeless animals of Harford County. Whether by yourself, a duo, a trio, or a team of up to 6 bowlers per lane, bowl to help the animals on Saturday, February 21, 2015 from 3:00-6:30 p.m. Everyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Please, no outside food or drink inside the bowling alley.



How do I support the animals?

Your \$20 registration fee covers your lane and shoe rental only. **The key to success is ASKING FOR DONATIONS!** Ask your friends, family, co-workers, neighbors, school friends, etc. to make a pledge (donation) to support you. **Let them know that their tax-deductible donations directly support the comfort and care of homeless animals at the shelter.** We accept cash and checks payable to HSHC. 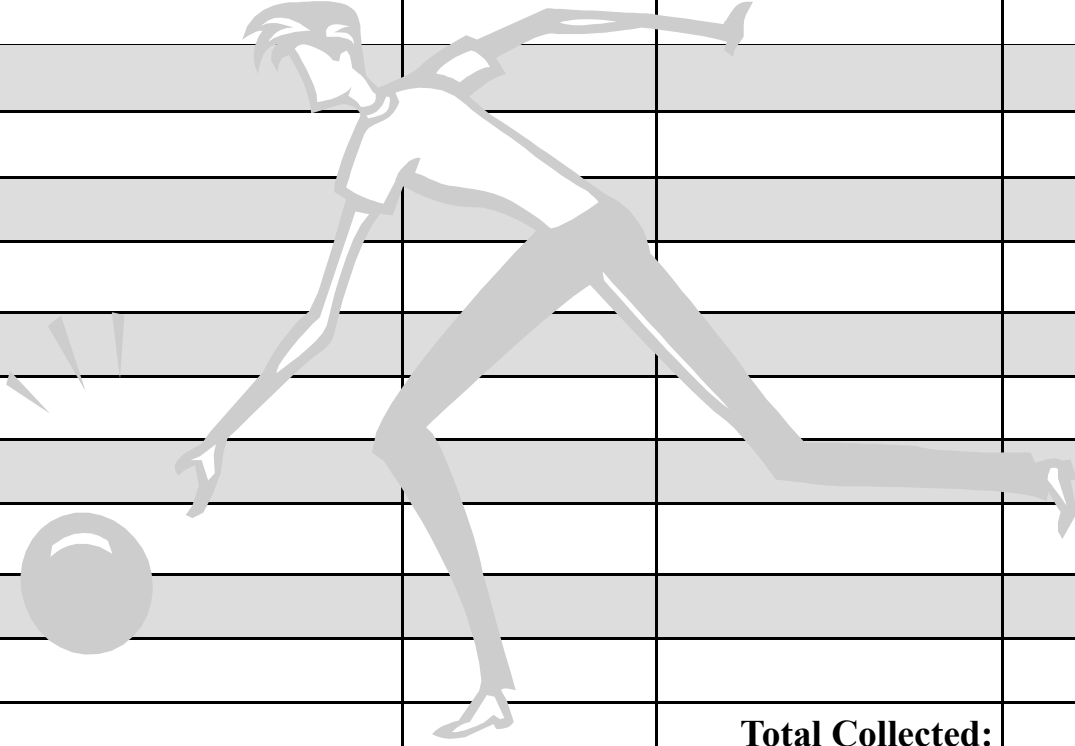
