## I Found Kittens. **Now What?**



THIS CHART WILL HELP YOU TAKE STEPS TO MAKE THE BEST DECISIONS FOR THEIR CARE!



Do any of the kittens appear sick or injured?



STOP! Take them to the ER or to a vet as soon as possible.



Estimate the kittens' age based on what they look like.

Eyes still closed or just beginning to open:

1-2 WEEKS OLD



Eyes open and alert, becoming mobile:

2-4 WEEKS OLD



Very mobile, can eat solid food:

4-6 WEEKS OLD



Very active & playful, weighs 1-2 lbs.:



Very active & playful, weighs 2+ lbs.:

8+ WEEKS OLD



## Do you see their mother around?





Has she returned to her kittens within a few hours?





TP: Avoid handling the kittens and watch them from a distance to see if the mama cat returns to care for them.
