who we are

The Humane Society of Harford County, Inc. (HSHC) is dedicated to the welfare and well-being of the approximately 2,500 animals that come to us each year—not only dogs and cats, but also reptiles, birds, livestock, rabbits, horses, rodents, wildlife, and even fish! We are an independent 501(c)(3) charitable organization. We are not a government agency or part of the Humane Society of the United States or any other national organization.

We are the only open admissions municipal shelter in all of Harford County. That means we take in every animal brought to us by County residents or from the Harford County Sheriff's Office Animal Control Unit, regardless of health, age, breed or behavior. We provide extensive medical treatment, surgery, behavior modification, and

foster care to ensure every animal – even those with special challenges – is given a safe refuge and a chance at adoption.

As a result of these extraordinary efforts, 98% of the animals that came through our doors last year were adopted or placed within the community.

In addition to pet adoption, HSHC offers programs to serve animals and the people that love them, including:

- Seniors for Seniors program. Waived adoption fees for those aged 62 and over.
- Lonely Hearts Club. Incentives to adopt overlooked pets
- Humane education programs for school-aged children & community groups

signature event: PUTTS FORE PAWS September 5


Putts Fore Paws is a wildly popular golf tournament held on the 1st Thursday of September at the award-winning Bulle Rock Golf Course in Havre de Grace. A shotgun start at 9am kicks off this premier event that features breakfast, lunch and dinner, on-course contests, raffles, golfer goodie bag with commemmorative t-shirt, digital photos of each foursome, door prizes, prizes for top three foursomes, and of course, appearances

by adoptable animals. 
deck the paws
